-  **2,682 lbs wood** A total of 9 trees that supplies enough oxygen for **5 people annually**.
-  **3,917 gal water** Enough water to take **228 eight-minute showers**.
-  **3 min BTUs energy** Enough energy to power an average American household for **11 days**.
-  **813 lbs emissions** Carbon sequestered by **9 tree seedlings** grown for 10 years.
-  **238 lbs solid waste** Trash thrown away by **52 people in a single day**.

Environmental impact estimates for savings pertaining to the use of post consumer recycled fiber share the same common reference data as the Environmental Defense Fund paper calculator, which is based on research done by the Paper Task Force, a peer-reviewed study of the lifecycle environmental impacts of paper production and disposal.
